

How to Accept Your Offer

When you receive your offer to attend Acadia University, you may have questions. You have an exciting road ahead here at Acadia. What follows is some information to help answer some questions you may have before you take your next steps.

What Do I Need To Accept My Offer?

It's easy. To secure your place in the program, you'll want to officially accept your offer as soon as possible online.

Steps:

1. Log in to your [Application Status Page](#)
 2. Click 'Accept My Offer' and fill out the admission response form.
 3. Submit your \$150 (CND) confirmation deposit.
 4. That's it!

Applying For Residence?

At Acadia, our campus is where it all happens. First year students are guaranteed residence placement. Rooms placements are made on a first come first serve basis, so the earlier you accept your offer, the earlier you can confirm your room. Once your admissions acceptance confirmation deposit has been made, a link to the Residence Application Form will be available on your [Status Page](#). A \$200 deposit will be required to secure your room placement.

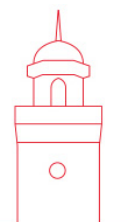
