



External User Agreement for proof of COVID Vaccination

Effective October 4, 2021, and following the Nova Scotia [COVID-19 Protocol for Proof of Full Vaccination for Events and Activities](#), people are required **by law** to show proof they are fully vaccinated to participate in discretionary, non-essential events and activities.

All attendees at events and activities held at Acadia University that include non-campus individuals (those who are not Acadia students, employees, or contractors) must show proof of vaccination for COVID-19. As the renter/event organizer (client) you must ensure that anyone 12 years of age or older who attends your event provides proof of full vaccination. For each new event, the client must provide a detailed plan demonstrating how the event will be managed and controlled in compliance with this and with all University policies. The plan must be submitted and pre-approved by the Occupational Health & Safety Coordinator, well in advance of the event date.

By signing below the client hereby acknowledges that they have reviewed the [COVID-19 Protocol for Proof of Full Vaccination for Events and Activities](#) and the [Proof of full vaccination guide for businesses](#) and agrees to provide the resources necessary to confirm vaccination compliance for all attendees at their event. In addition, the client agrees to provide Acadia, a signed confirmation that the process has been successfully carried out following each event.
