



Call for Nominations 2021 Acadia Alumni Isaac Chipman Award for Excellence in Alumni Service

The *Acadia Alumni Isaac Chipman Award for Excellence in Alumni Service* recognizes an alumnus or alumna of Acadia University who has had a significant positive impact on Acadia and its alumni. The award focuses on a recipient who has provided consistent support in the form of time, effort and resources to the services and promotion of the advancement of the University and its alumni.

Consideration in the selection process is given to the following criteria:

- **Breadth of Involvement** - The range, diversity and magnitude of the candidate's involvement in, contributions towards, and efforts in support of the advancement of the University and its alumni.
- **Depth of Involvement** - The value and impact of the candidate's involvement in, contributions towards, and efforts in support of the advancement of the University and its alumni.
- **Duration of Involvement** –The period of time or years of sustained contributions towards and efforts in support of the advancement of the University and its alumni.

Nominations must be submitted by **May 31, 2021** for consideration for the 2021 award. The time and place of the award presentation will be based on several variables: program schedule of the Alumni Office; geographical location of recipient.

Guidelines for Nominations

1. A completed copy of this nomination form.
2. A brief summary or letter describing the nominee's contributions and your reasons for nominating the candidate.
3. If available, a nominee's CV.
4. A minimum of one (1) additional reference letter supporting this nomination (maximum five letters of reference).
5. Any additional supporting documentation you would like included for consideration by the selection committee (e.g. copies of relevant articles that illustrate the nominee's achievements and service).

- 5) *Nominations are considered for up to five consecutive years and the nominator may add supporting information annually or withdraw the nomination at any point.*
