

United States Visitor Visa

You will need a travel waiver authorization or visitor visa (DS-160) if you are visiting the United States unless you are Canadian.

- **FEES:** All U.S. Consulates in Canada require that **visa fee payments must be deposited in advance of the appointment.**
- **Reciprocity fee:** Depending on your country of citizenship, you may also be required to pay a fee for visa issuance, known as reciprocity fee. If your visa application is approved, you will be asked to pay this fee at the time of your interview. [Click here](#) to find out whether you will need to pay a reciprocity fee.

To obtain a US visa, you must complete the **Online Nonimmigrant Visa Application (DS- 160)** first then visit the [United States embassy](#) website to book an appointment at the consulate in [Halifax](#). When you are booking your appointment, they will give you instructions and the documents you need to obtain before going to your appointment.
