<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All caps must be removed.</li> <li>➤ Don't crush cans, plastic containers or Tetra Paks.</li> <li>➤ No broken glass.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Everything must be clean and dry. Food containers must be washed</li> <li>➤ All caps must be removed.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All foil or plastic liners and metal fasteners must be removed from any food boxes/bags.</li> <li>➤ If corrugated cardboard is too large to fit in the bag it should be flattened, bundled, and placed beside the recycling bin.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Make sure any non-organic pieces are removed.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All caps must be removed.</li> <li>➤ Don't crush cans, plastic containers or Tetra Paks.</li> <li>➤ No broken glass.</li> </ul>
Other Things You Should Know				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There's a separate container for broken glass.</li> <li>• There are battery recycling stations on the lower floor of each residence.</li> </ul>
